

# SLICC \* sandboxed sub-agents

Web Asset Container - HTML, CSS and JavaScript carried as PDF attachments, run in a sandboxed frame by the wac-pdf block.

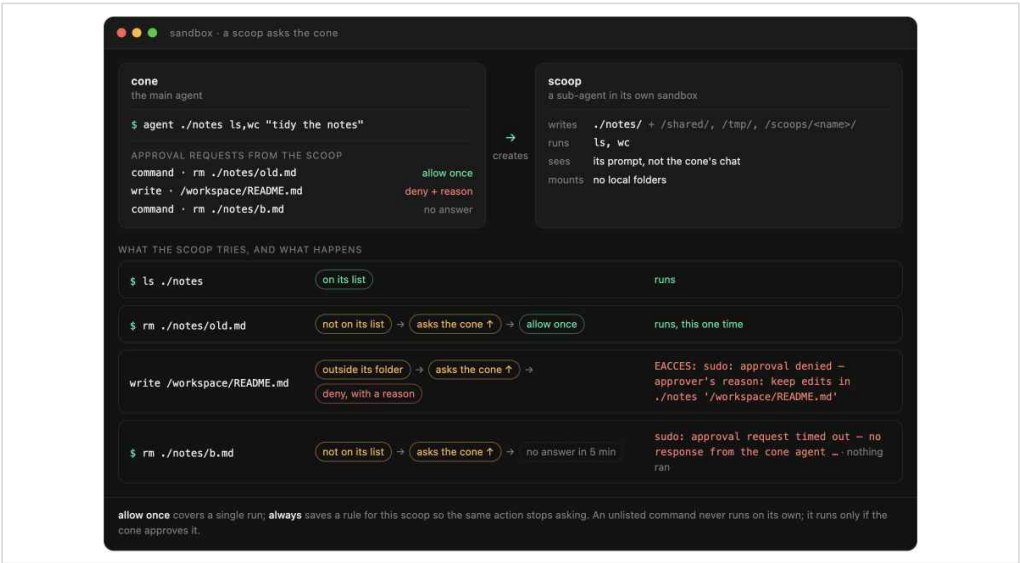


Diagram of the SLICC sandbox: the cone (the main agent) creates a scoop whose writes are limited to its own folder and whose commands are limited to ls and wc. ls runs directly; rm and a write outside the folder each go to the cone as an approval request, which allows rm once, denies the write with a reason the scoop reads, and lets a third request time out after five minutes so nothing runs.
